Regina Hobbs and her mother, Betty, came to PACE in September 2024 seeking housing assistance in Champaign-Urbana as their lease was ending in October. While waiting for

their housing application to be processed, they faced the risk of homelessness. PACE stepped in, using \$200 from the McKinley Foundation grant to fund a 3-night hotel stay, providing them with a safe place to stay.

With an additional partnership and support from Cunningham Township, Regina and Betty were able to move into a new apartment and avoid homelessness!


